Catherine McAuley Celebration Day: Tomorrow we will celebrate McAuley Day and our wonderful School Patron, the Venerable Catherine McAuley. What a day it will be!! We will start our celebrations with Mass at 9.30am, then flow into a jam-packed day of great activities. It would be wonderful to have you join us for all or part of the day. It will be a celebration of our School community and a time to acknowledge all that is so good about our school, under the patronage of the Venerable Catherine McAuley.

Mission Month: When we come back to school next term, we will be focusing on Catholic Missions. Traditionally, the month of October is devoted to Missions, and we spend the first two weeks of next Term learning about the work of Catholic Missions and raising money for specific projects.
